



Sound Reading is a foundational reading intervention program that addresses many of the underlying causes of reading difficulty such as auditory processing and phonemic awareness. Reading is an aspect of spoken language that requires well-honed listening, memory and attention skills. Learning to read is like learning to speak.

Because the English language is so complex, it is NORMAL to confuse letter names with letter sounds. Sound Reading’s sequence of sound-based activities and the method of instruction allow letters and sounds to be learned together.
